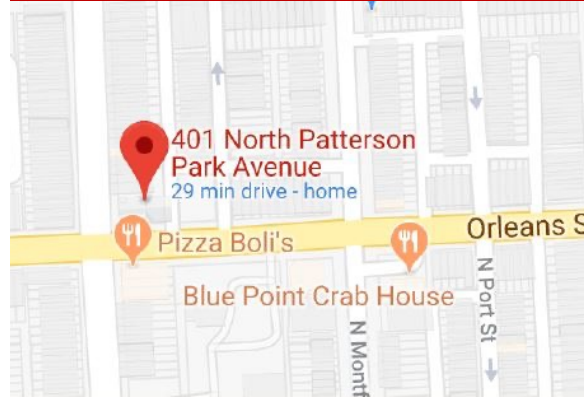


what's in it for me?

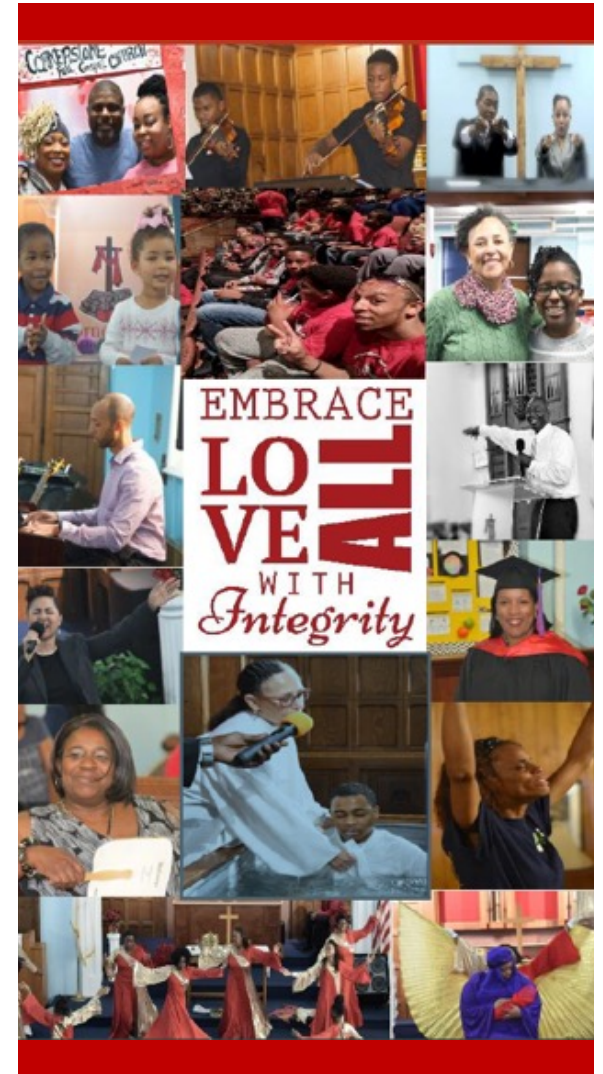

We provide educational opportunities to learn about the Bible and how to apply it to your life:

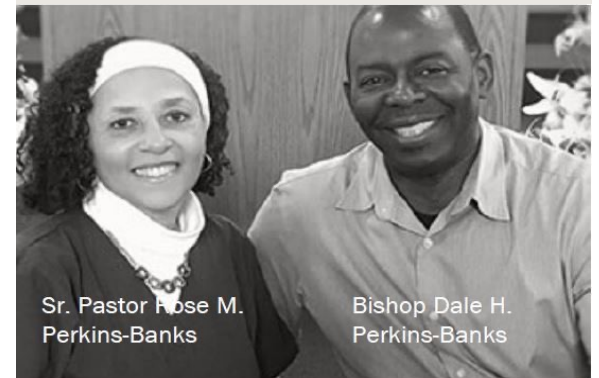
- ❖ Children & Youth Church (Sunday after Intercessory Prayer)
